Upheaval: Hanover, NH January 31, 2001

on Friday in India the earth moved unexpectedly and shook down houses like matchsticks whole towns of 35,000 were leveled as many as 15,000 may have disappeared in the rubble --It is not a region one newscaster intoned --unfamiliar with disasters but such numbers defy belief rescue crews put the survival limit at 100 hours yet five days later people are delivered from the debris a woman is unearthed, her seven month old baby in her lap swaddled in blood still breathing

on Saturday in our narrow valley of students and scholars a region unfamiliar with such disasters our world unhinged as surely as the shifting of tectonic plates a sudden blow took your lives Susanne and Half

for weeks we huddled together in shock but rather than taking comfort we relive your last moments trying to imagine what we can not know about violent senseless murder over and over in desperation we try to bear with you as if our bearing your death could bear it away nothing could prepare us for this we are not ready to let you go
