

Robert W. Staiger is the Roth Family Distinguished Professor in the Arts and Sciences and Professor of Economics at Dartmouth College, a Research Associate of the National Bureau of Economic Research, and a Fellow of the Econometric Society. An Editor of the *Journal of International Economics* from 2010 through 2017, Staiger specializes in the study of international trade policy rules and institutions, with particular emphasis on the economics of the GATT/WTO. His research has been published in a variety of academic journals, and in two books, [The Economics of the World Trading System](#), co-authored with Kyle Bagwell and published by MIT Press (2002), and [A World Trading System for the Twenty-First Century](#), published by MIT Press in its Ohlin Lecture series in December of 2022. Staiger also served as Editor, with Kyle Bagwell, of [The Handbook of Commercial Policy](#), published by Elsevier in December 2016.
