- SENIOR RESEARCH DINNER MAY 29

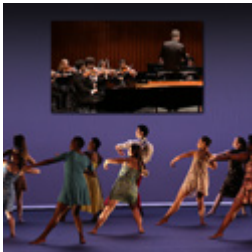

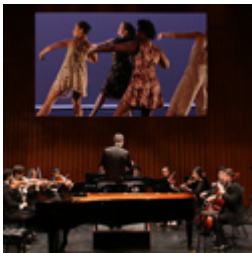
