

Ambassador Carson was sworn in as assistant secretary of state for the bureau of African affairs, on May 7, 2009. (2003-2006). He has also served as U.S. Ambassador to Kenya, Zimbabwe, and Uganda, and as a Peace Corps volunteer in Tanzania.


