Jake Sullivan is a renowned American policymaker and analyst for international affairs. He served as National Security Advisor to Vice President Joe Biden and prior to that as Director of Policy Planning at the State Department under Secretary Hillary Clinton, a job he took at the age of thirty-four (Time Magazine included him in its "40 under 40" of rising stars in American politics). During the Presidential election of 2016, Jake Sullivan was Hillary Clinton's top foreign policy adviser.

Jake Sullivan is a **prolific writer and commentator** on US international affairs. Apart from being a commentator at CNN, his writings have appeared in Foreign Policy, Foreign Affairs. The New York Times and The Washington Post.
