- Westians in the News

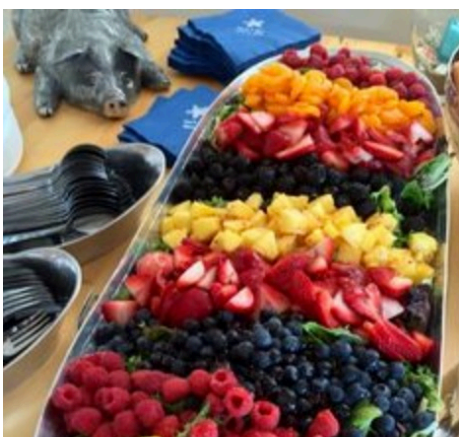

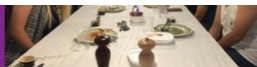
