Greetings from Hanover. I'm thinking of you all as we come to the last week of term.

I'm also thinking of you all at this important moment of reckoning in our society. You've seen a lot of statements about what's going on the past couple weeks, so I'll try and keep this brief.

Like so many in our community, I am outraged by the killing of George Floyd, Ahmaud Arbery, and Breonna Taylor, and by the pattern of violence against Black Americans and long history of systemic racism they represent.

However I'm also encouraged by the actions of many, including those in the Dartmouth community, who are protesting injustice and working to better our society, often facing personal challenges and sometimes, deplorably, even more violence. It's clear that we all have a responsibility to listen to Black voices and to act against systemic racism. I learned a great deal from yesterday's "Open Conversation", and I look forward to more discussions and actions around these issues in West House in the future.

In the meantime, good luck for the end of term and best wishes to you all and your loved ones.


